Naming Committee Meeting Minutes
October 7, 2004

Natalie Burnett opened the Naming Committee Meeting by having the committee member introduce themselves. Committee members in attendance: Lee Jordan, Bob Gill, Helen Sharratt, Andrea Waters, Carrie McCuratain, Nancy Davis, Lt. Col. David Jones, Angela Weiss and Cathy Smith. Also in attendance: Mike Henry, Executive Director, High School Education, Natalie Burnett, New Eagle River High School Principal, Kenny Ray, Financial Data Control Clerk,

Committee member Lee Jordan began by nominating Glenn Briggs High School.

Bob Gill nominated Eagle River High School and Glenn Briggs High School.

Helen Sharratt nominated Eagle River High School.

Andrea Waters nominated North High School and Hiland High School.

Carrie McCurtain nominated Eagle River High School and Hiland High School.

Nancy Davis nominated Glenn Briggs High School and Joe Reddington Sr. High School

LTC David Jones nominated Eagle River High School and Eagle River Valley High School.

Angela Weiss nominated Hiland High School and Eagle River High School.

Cathy Smith nominated Glenn Briggs High School and Hiland High School.

Ms. Burnett announced the six name nominations. Eagle River High School, Hiland High School, Glenn Briggs High School, Joe Reddington Sr. High School, North High School, and Eagle River Valley High School.

Ms. Burnett distributed ballots to the committee members only. The committee members were asked to complete their ballots by a point value ranging from one to four.

Mike Henry read the ballots and Ms. Burnett tallied the points.

Ms. Burnett read the final names and points. Eagle River High School received 24 points, Glenn Briggs High School received 17 points, Hiland High School received 20 points, Eagle River Valley High School received 3 points, Joe Reddington Sr. received 3 points., North High School received 3 points.

Ms. Burnett announced that four name nominations are needed in order to proceed with the selection process. The top three names are: Eagle River High School, Glenn Briggs High School and Hiland High School. Three names were tied as the fourth choice: Eagle River Valley High School, North High School and Joe Reddington Sr. High School. Another vote was taken to break the tie. Ms. Burnett distributed another ballot to committee members and the fourth place name nomination vote is as follows: North High School 1 point, Joe Reddington Sr. High School 1 point, Eagle River Valley High School 7 points.

Next week's task for the committee members will be to present one choice from the final four names.

Mr. Henry announced there will be a Public Forum Meeting on October 21, 2004 at Gruening Middle School Multi-Purpose Room to discuss questions on sports, zone exception, programs, etc. He encouraged committee members to attend.

Ms. Burnett thanked the committee members for their help in the naming of the new Eagle River High School and reminded them to bring a final name nomination from the final four names chosen today.
